FREE SCHOOL MEALS

As a result of school closures due to the Coronavirus outbreak, the Minister for Education and Minister for Communities has agreed to make payment of £2.70 per child, per day to families who have been assessed as eligible for free school meals. Please visit the Education Authority's website for more information. Payments will commence week commencing 30th March and continue fortnightly.

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TRANSFER- AQE

Before we got off, I spoke with P6 about the AQE transfer test in P7. If your child intends to do this, please confirm this with myself or Mrs Allen during the week beginning 20th April. We will then be in touch with you to arrange additional tasks and tests for your child. In the meantime, you may want to sign up to 'The Transfer Tutor' to help prepare your child, as it has a specific focus on NI AQE tests.

KEY WORKERS

The school has remained open over the last two weeks and will be open for some days during the Easter holidays for supervision of children of key workers, who have no other viable childcare facility to facilitate them getting to work. This is for supervision only. I am grateful to the school staff who are providing this service for those parents in need.

If you need to avail of this service, please email me by **3pm each Friday** to tell me your requirements for the following week. We aim to maintain this service as long as we have adequate staff cover.
