Sickness

We have experienced a particularly bad period of illness with pupils and staff. If your child is sick, please keep them at home until they are well enough for school. Some children have been sent to school, after being ill during the night or prior to coming to school. These pupils are then spreading bugs to others.

There is currently a shortage of substitute teaching staff, therefore, if a staff member is off ill, it is becoming increasingly difficult to provide cover for classes. One day this week, we had to move nursery to remote learning, as we could not obtain any substitute staff and I was already teaching another class.

I am very grateful to the staff who were in school, as they have covered various classes, supervisory duties and have been cleaning the school. Our classroom assistants have been amazing, they are very capable, taking on any role when required.

I hope our staffing situation improves. The governors have discussed this situation and if we do not have sufficient staff to cover classes, we may have to move some classes to remote learning, on a rota basis. Please be prepared for this as we do not get a lot of notice. Moving to remote learning is a last resort but we have to risk assess on health and safety grounds. I'm sure you have seen the news and this has been happening in many schools across Northern Ireland.

Covid- we continue to have cases of Covid throughout the school. We would ask that you continue to look out for symptoms and get a PCR test for your child if necessary. Many of the children in school are testing positive on day 8, following close contact with a positive case.

Christmas Technology

Just a reminder that if Santa does happen to bring your child some new technology for Christmas, please remember to set up parental controls on these devices. Please also keep a close eye on what your child is using their device for.

'Healthy, Happy Minds' is a new initiative funded by DE/EA. A small amount of money has been made available to all schools to support children and their mental health.

We are currently in the process of identifying children who may benefit from this support. If you have any particular concerns regarding your child and how they are coping with school or life in general, please let us know by sending an email to their class teacher or myself.

We will then prioritise who we think would benefit most from this service. This will be confidential and the pupils will be supported by a fully recognised and accredited professional. Should your child be prioritised for this we will contact you.

Finally, I would like to thank you all for your support to the staff this term. On behalf of the governors, staff and pupils, I would like to wish you all a very happy and peaceful family Christmas.
